CANAAN DOG CLUB OF AMERICA
ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

The Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels/campgrounds in the future.

Any individual attending a CDCA sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairgrounds has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all for the following actions by the CDCA Board of Directors:

- 1) May be banned from showing at the next CDCA Sanctioned event(s).
- 2) May be subject to AKC sanctions.
- 3) Membership in the CDCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damage shall be defined as:

- 1) Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (wall, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2) Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3) Any verified complaint by a CDCA Member.

CDCA Room Regulations:

- 1) All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with dog.
- 2) Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3) No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms.
- 4) Dogs are to be allowed only on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protected covering provided by the owner/handler.
- 5) All owners/handlers will take preventive measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to their arriving at the hotel/campsite.
- 6) Protective sheeting shall be placed under all crates in hotels. (Whenever possible, such sheeting will be provided by the host group and will be given to the hotel to dispense at the time of check-in.)

THE CANAAN DOG CLUB OF AMERICA INC.'S ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY IS REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED AS PART OF ANY OF THE CLUB'S AGILITY TRIAL PREMIUMS; BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM, THE EXHIBITOR AGREES TO ABIDE BY THIS POLICY AND ALL OF ITS CONDITIONS.

TRIAL SITE

These trials will be held in a large indoor fan-cooled arena on dirt. There is plenty of room for crating indoors, and lots of grassy area to walk dogs. A concession stand will be open during trial hours, and there are a number of restaurants and fast food establishments nearby. Clemson restaurants and lodging establishments are roughly 4 miles to the west; Anderson restaurants and lodgings are roughly 8 miles to the east.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the South: Take I-85 exit 14 and go left on Hwy 187 North. Proceed 5.9 miles. Turn left on Hwy 76/28 West. Go 2.1 miles and turn left on Queen Street. The T. Ed Garrison Arena will be on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.

From the North: Take I-85 exit 19B (Hwy 76/28 West) and go 7.7 miles. Turn left on Queen Street; facility will be on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.

From Clemson: From Hwy 123, take Hwy 76/28 East and go 3.3 miles. Turn right on Queen Street. Arena will be on your left in .5 miles. Enter at Arena Parking sign.

Note: follow signs to the arena when you turn onto Queen Street.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC ILP, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners Listing numbers, or are approved FSS breeds. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect their physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 6 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.
- The trial-giving clubs, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the events.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- Refunds of less than \$5 will not be made.
- **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.** Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials".
- **Bitches in season are not eligible to compete.** Bitches in heat may be withdrawn after closing and the entry fee (less \$2.50/run—our direct costs) returned upon request of the competitor prior to the start of the trial. **All requests must be accompanied by a veterinarian's letter.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The AKC reminds all exhibitors that dogs showing any signs of illness or communicable disease should not be brought to the events.
- Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is ineligible to compete. Illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Dogs without a valid jump height card/form may still compete, but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class. This measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. Dogs entered in the 24" or 26" height division are excepted from this requirement. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, ALL dogs without a valid jump height card/form just be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure before the dog's first run of the trial. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running, and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

MOVE-UPS

Move-up requests for Friday must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, November 22, 2010 at 6 p.m. They may be emailed to pegfranklin@morrisbb.net. Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested. Move-ups for Saturday/Sunday must include the above information and must be delivered to the Trial Secretary at the trial site no later than 20 minutes after the final dog has run on the previous day. Dogs moved up will generally be placed at the end of the running order.

CONFIRMATIONS

If you provide a valid, legible email address, final confirmation of your entry and a schedule of judging will be sent to the email address provided—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. **Please be sure that the Trial Secretary's email address is not blocked and is on your approved senders list.** If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received a copy of your confirmation five days before the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Rosettes and plush toys (valued at \$1-\$3) will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. CDCA pewter medallions will be given to those dogs who earn new titles, and QQ

ribbons will also be available for those dogs earning a double Q in the Excellent B classes. MACH and PAX ribbons and bars will be awarded to dogs that earn these titles.

THE LADA L MEMORIAL CHALLENGE TROPHY

The Lada L Memorial Challenge Trophy is a hand-painted DanieleTrottier original work depicting Lada L and various agility scenes on a large wooden jar. It is offered by the members and friends of the Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. in honor and in memory of Alan Gersman's agility partner **MACH Max's Lada L P Tiger Pooh**, the breed's first Master Agility Champion. A dog is eligible for the Lada L award in:

- Excellent if it is entered in Excellent for both Standard and Jumpers (entered in the Regular classes, not Preferred),
- Open if it is entered in Open for both Standard and Jumpers (Regular classes, not Preferred)
- Novice if it is entered in Novice for both Standard and Jumpers (Regular classes, not Preferred).

The award is given to the highest combined scoring, double Q-ing dog of any breed in its respective level. If there are two or more dogs with the highest score, any ties will be broken by calculating which dog ran the combined highest percentage under its standard course time.

To retire this trophy a handler must qualify three times at a Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. agility trial, not necessarily in the same class, or with the same dog or at consecutive trials. The Lada L Memorial Challenge trophy will remain the property of and in possession of the Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. until it is retired. A commemorative item (hand-painted Daniele Trottier original work) will be given to each High Scoring qualifier from each class (Novice, Open and Excellent) until the trophy is retired. High scoring qualifier from each class (Novice, Open and Excellent) will be recorded on the trophy until it is retired.

A CDCA pewter medallion will also be awarded to **highest scoring Canaan Dog** in Novice, Open, and Excellent each day, scored using the same procedure as for the Lada L trophy.

HOW TO ENTER THE TRIAL

Use the official entry form that accompanies this premium. Be sure you include the correct amount of money. **PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE** your check to the entry form. Entry fees of \$16 per run include AKC recording fees of \$3 for each run. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned. If you include a **legible** email address, we will notify you of the acceptance status of your entry. Dogs may not switch between Regular and Preferred classes within the weekend. **Be sure to circle the DAYS AND CLASSES you want to enter at the top of the form.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776.
