Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to clean up after their dogs! It has become increasing difficult for dog clubs to find sites for dog shows as well as hotels that are willing to accept dogs. This is due in large part to a small fraction of people who have allowed their dogs to soil and/or damage the facilities we wish to enjoy.

At the hotel, exhibitors will need to place a plastic sheet under your dogs' crates. It is also requested that dogs are crated at all times when you are not in your room & that you do not leave your dogs unattended in your room for extended periods of time. The Canaan Dog Club of America, Inc. has adopted a policy in order to insure that its exhibitors and their dogs will be welcome at hotel/campgrounds in the future. Remember to carry a plastic bag with you whenever you walk your dog. The Midwest Canaan Dog Club will provide extra plastic bags for anyone that needs them. If your dog soils the hotel grounds, parking lot, show grounds, or ring, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this show, you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing. Thank you for your cooperation.

### **ADDITIONAL AND SPECIAL NOTICES**

- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping his/her area clean. All waste including feces, hair, grooming materials must be cleaned up and properly disposed of before leaving show site.
  - Owners/handlers are responsible for any feces left by their animals and disposing of it in a sanitary manner.
  - No baby carriages or strollers in show area.
  - Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
  - Dogs allowed in ring during judging only.
  - Dogs must be ready for Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
  - The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
  - There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

**VETERAN DOG CLASS      VETERAN BITCH CLASS**

For Dogs & Bitches 7 years of age and older. Per AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class**-For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be Neutered and does NOT need to be entered in Another Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

**Brood Bitch Class**-Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class**-A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner and **MUST BE** entered in Another Class at this Show. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

The Midwest Canaan Dog Club will offer Awards of Merit in recognition of the quality of dogs/bitches in the Best Of Breed Competition. It is solely the judge's decision whether or not to give all available Awards of Merit, only one or some, or none at all. Awards of Merit recipients are selected from the dogs & bitches in the Best Of Breed Competition, other than the Best Of Breed winner, Best of Winners winner, & Best Opposite Sex winner. The number of Awards of Merit that may be given is determined by the size of the Best Of Breed competition entry: 3-5 Specials = 1 AOM; 6-8 Specials = 2 AOM; 9-11 Specials = 3 AOM; 12-14 Specials = 4 AOM; 15 or more Specials = 5 AOM

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
